## Whakaweti tuihono

Ko te kōrero, te mahi tuihono rānei ka whakamamae, ka tūkinu rānei i tētahi atu tangata. Whakamōhio atu ki te pae pāhopori, ki Netsafe hoki, hei whakahaumarū i a koe, ā, āraia te tangata nāna te mahi tūkinu.

## Cyber- or online bullying

Someone saying or doing something unkind or unsafe to someone else online. Report cyberbullying to the platform and to Netsafe, and block abusive individuals to protect yourself.



## Tapuwae matihiko

## Digital Footprint

The traces of personal information and online activity that are left behind while using the internet. Be cautious about what you publish and where you share. Think about your online privacy and review platform settings.



## Hoko tuihono

Te hoko tuihono, te kurutete tuihono rānei. Whakamahia ngā paetukutuku whakawhirinaki, kua whiwhi hoki i ngā arotake pai, ā, tukuna ngā taipitopito pārongo ki ngā paetukutuku haumarū anake. Rapua te tohu “https://” me te ata raka kei roto i te pae wāhitau, kia haumarū ake ai ngā kurutete tuihono.

## Online shopping

Purchasing or transacting online. Use trusted sites and sellers with good reviews, and only enter payment details into secure websites. Look for “https://” and a padlock icon in the address bar for safer online transactions.



## Hītinihanga

Te ngana ki te tāhae i ngā pārongo tūmataiti, tērā pea mā te īmēra tinihanga, te paetukutuku tinihanga rānei. Huakina kō ērā o ngā īmēra, ngā karere rānei kua tae mai i ngā tāngata e mōhio ana koe, e pono ana koe anake, ā, kua e pāwhiri i ngā hononga - pātotohia te wāhitau paetukutuku mai i te tīmatanga.



## Pātuhi ai

Ko tēnei te ingoa mō te mahi tuku, te mahi whiwhi rānei i ngā ihirangi e pā ana ki te mahi ai, tae ana ki ngā ata, ngā ataata me ngā tuinga rānei he kiri kau kei roto. He mea waiwai te whaiwhakaaro ki ngā tūraru i mua i te tuku i ngā ihirangi ki te ipurangi.



## Motuhēhēnga taurua (2FA, he motuhēhēnga tukarua)

He paparanga haumarua anō, ka whakaū kia tukuna e te kaiwhakamahi ngā momo hāpono e rua, i mua i te whakauru ki te pūkete. Whakaritea te motuhēhēnga tukarua ki te whakahaumarua i tō pūkete, kei whakamahia e te tāhae.



## Whatunga Tūmataiti Mariko (VPN):

Whakamahia tētahi VPN ki te whakamuna i ngā raraunga e tukuna ana e koe mā te waeakore (wi-fi), ki te whakapiki i te haumarua o te whakamahinga o ngā whatunga waeakore he tūmatanui, ā, kāore i te whakamaruhia.

## Phishing

A fraudulent attempt to obtain sensitive information, often through deceptive emails or websites. Only open emails or messages from people you know and trust, and don't click links – type out website addresses from scratch.

## Sexting (or sending nudes)

The name given to the act of sending or receiving sexual content including nude images, videos or texts. It's important to consider risks before sending any content online.

## Two-Factor Authentication (2FA, multi-factor authentication)

An extra layer of security that requires users to provide two different types of verification before accessing an account. Set up two-factor authentication to help protect your account from fraudulent use.

## VPN: Virtual Private Network

Use a VPN to encrypt the data you send over wi-fi and to make it safer to use unsecured public wi-fi networks.
