- Pay direct, bypass systems

- · Verify account by logging in
- Give us remote access

Money could look like:

- · Pay a 'processing' fee for prize
- Send giftcards to help online friend

If you've already paid money:

- Contact your bank immediately.
- Reach out to your family/ whānau for support.
- Contact Netsafe for advice about next steps.
